Selfless: Paul's Letter to the Romans

Romans 14:1-12 – page 948

The mercies of God motivates our consecration through transformed thinking (12:1-2)—first about ourselves (12:3), then about our role within the body of Christ demonstrated particularly in humble service (12:4-8), evident in active love (12:9-21; 13:8-10) and proper submission (13:1-7) in light of the urgency the time (13:11-14). So how do we actively love when others have different perspectives?
