Selfless: Paul's Letter to the Romans

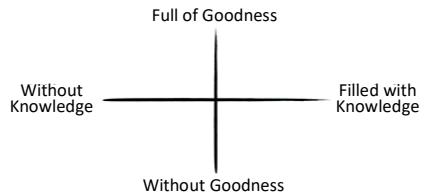
Romans 15:14-33 (page 949)
