Did You Know? We want you to know how grateful we are for your faithful stewardship during these past three months! Even though total giving has declined slightly, as we anticipated, expenses are down significantly. We are particularly thankful that we were able to keep our staff fully employed during this time. Since the Elders have prudently decided to keep our 2020-21 budget the same as last year, the numbers in the bulletin will not change with the new fiscal year beginning July 1. We will closely monitor income and expenditures over the next 90 days to determine if any adjustments should be made beginning on October 1 and inform you of any changes.

MATCHING GIFT UPDATE: Last Monday, construction started on our RENEW2020 Fellowship Hall renovations. We have a generous donor who will match the first \$250,000 in contributions from our church family. This week, we surpassed the \$100,000 mark in gifts and commitments! Praise the Lord!
