Choose Your Words Cautiously – James 3:1-18

We need to choose our words *intentionally* in order to build up not tear down. We need to choose our words *slowly* by being quick to hear, slow to speak and slow to anger. Today, we learn that we must choose our words *cautiously* because our tongues are untamable. Is that even possible? Let's discover together . . .

The Problem: My Untamable Tongue (3:1-12)
