There are commonly held beliefs about the Bible, God, Jesus and Christianity that are just not true. When going through difficulties, a well-meaning person might try to encourage you by saying *God Won't Give You More Than You Can Handle*. Is this true? Is it found in the Bible? Why Does God Give Us More Than We Can Handle?

1. So We Depend On and Experience His Power Paul Depended on God's Power (2 Cor. 1:8-11)

Paul Experienced Christ's Power (2 Cor. 12:7-10)

2. So We Depend On and Experience His Presence

Moses – "I will be with you" (Exodus 3-4)

Joshua – "The LORD is with you wherever you go." (Joshua 1)

Gideon – "I will be with you." (Judges 6)

Disciples – "I am with you always . . . " (Matthew 28)

3. So We Depend On and Understand His Purpose

James – perfect and complete, lacking in nothing (James 1:2-4)

Peter – praise and glory and honor (1 Peter 1:3-9)
