

Coaches are volunteers whose primary ministry is to the adult leaders and teen leaders. Coaches will typically oversee between 3 to 4 Student Groups (approximately 6 to 9 leaders). Coaches are responsible to assist leaders to be the best they can be for their groups by making sure that logistic issues are resolved, discussion questions are answered, and that the groups (and/or leaders) are on schedule with their responsibilities. We do this with heavy doses of prayer, accountability and encouragement.

PROFILE:

- Spiritual maturity that allows you to be a "leader of leaders."
- Practices disciplines of daily prayer (for leaders and students) and personal study of God's Word
- Gifts such as: Leadership, Shepherding, Administration, and Encouragement.
- Should have experience in evaluating / leading / developing adult leaders.
- Must be able to...
 - ...Build momentum: Encourage, Encourage, Encourage!
 - ...Communicate: Keep group(s) informed
 - ...Solve Problems: Proactively shepherd and head-off potential issues

RESPONSIBILITIES:

WEEKLY:

- Connect and communicate with group leaders weekly
- Visit group(s) occasionally be available to visit groups when leaders are absent
- Encourage the 5 Essentials with leaders

MONTHLY:

- Attend and participate in scheduled LEAD Meetings (Leaders' Equipping And Developing)
- Attend coaches' meetings (scheduled periodically on Wednesday nights during the year)
- Provide logistic assistance with Leaders on Wednesday night as needed

ANNUALLY:

- There are several big events that occur during the year where coach involvement is required...Fusion, Winter Retreat & Go Weekend
- Assist in the promotion of big events to the group leaders and students
- Consider being a part of a Summer Missions' Team
