This packet contains the worksheets you will use for the final three lessons of the semester, learning about ***Our Union with Christ*** and its real-life impact in our everyday lives. Because of the upcoming holidays and conclusion of our semester, there will not be in-depth homework like we had in our study of 1 Thessalonians. Instead, for each of these final lessons, you will simply work through the scripture passages for each week using the study skills you have learned this semester. 😊

1. In your time at home, do careful observation and interpretation of the passages for that week. Spend most of your time on the scriptures on the first page for that specific lesson, but make yourself familiar with the scriptures on any additional pages. (Don't worry about filling in any blanks; we'll cover that during the teaching time.)
2. In the teaching video, I will lead you through the passages, diagrams, conclusions, etc. Think of it as a workshop format, where we do the work *together*, rather than relying more heavily on homework.

Romans 6:1-13

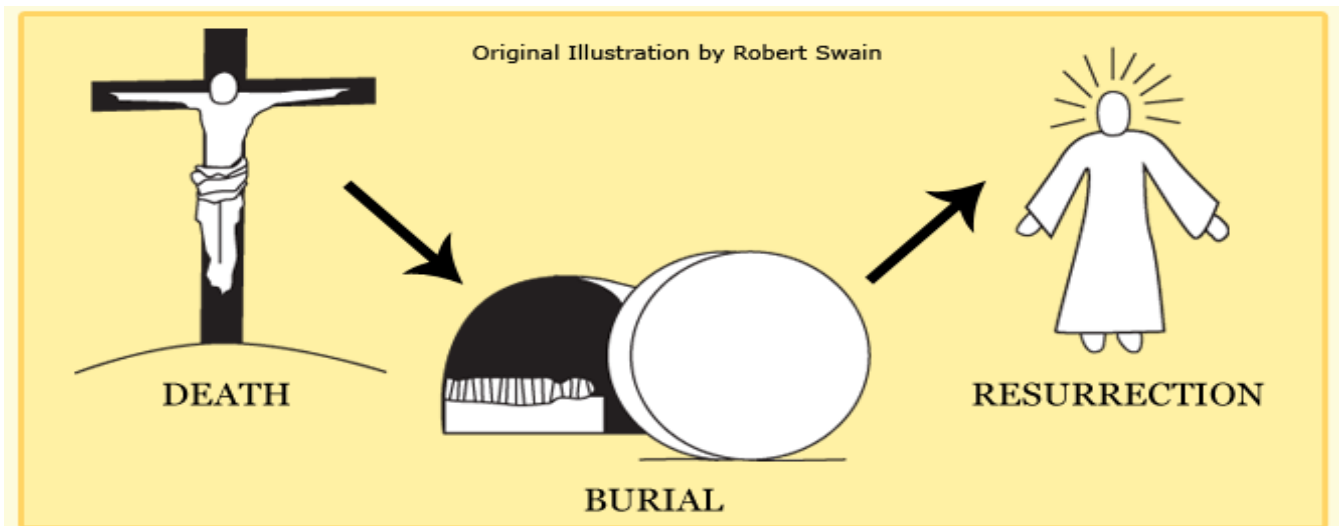
¹ What shall we say then? Are we to continue in sin so that grace may increase? ² Far from it! How shall we who died to sin still live in it? ³ Or do you not know that all of us who have been baptized into Christ Jesus have been baptized into His death? ⁴ Therefore we have been buried **with** Him through baptism into death, so that, just as Christ was raised from the dead through the glory of the Father, so we too may walk in newness of life. ⁵ For if we have become united **with** Him in the likeness of His death, certainly we shall also be united **with** Him in the likeness of His resurrection, ⁶ knowing that our old self was crucified **with** Him, in order that our body of sin might be done away with, so that we would no longer be slaves to sin; ⁷ for the one who has died is freed from sin.

⁸ Now if we have died **with** Christ, we believe that we shall also live **with** Him, ⁹ knowing that Christ, having been raised from the dead, is never to die again; death no longer is master over Him. ¹⁰ For the death that He died, He died to sin, once for all; but the life that He lives, He lives to God. ¹¹ So you too, consider yourselves to be dead to sin, but alive to God in Christ Jesus.

¹² Therefore do not let sin reign in your mortal body so that you obey its lusts, ¹³ and do not go on presenting the members of your body to sin as instruments of unrighteousness; but present yourselves to God as those who are alive from the dead, and your members as instruments of righteousness to God.

¹ I urge you therefore, brothers, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies as a living and holy sacrifice, acceptable to God, which is your spiritual service of worship.

Colossians 3:5-10, 12-14

⁵ Therefore consider the members of your earthly body as dead to sexual immorality, impurity, passion, evil desire, and covetousness, which amounts to idolatry. ⁶ For it is on account of these things that the wrath of God will come. ⁷ In them you also once walked, when you were living in them. ⁸ But now you must put them all aside: anger, wrath, malice, slander, and obscene talk from your mouth. ⁹ Do not lie to one another, since you have put off the old self with its practices ¹⁰ and have put on the new self, which is being renewed in a true knowledge after the image of its creator....

¹² And so, as those who have been chosen of God, holy and beloved, put on a heart of compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness, and patience; ¹³ bearing with one another, and forgiving each other, whoever has a complaint against anyone; just as the Lord forgave you, so also should you.

¹⁴ And beyond all these things put on love, which is the perfect bond of unity.

Ephesians 4:21-32

²¹ ...You have been taught in Him... ²² that, in reference to your former way of life, you are to lay aside the old self, which is being corrupted in accordance with the lusts of deceit, ²³ and that you are to be renewed in the spirit of your mind, ²⁴ and put on the new self, which in the likeness of God has been created in righteousness and holiness of the truth.

²⁵ Therefore, laying aside falsehood, SPEAK TRUTH EACH ONE OF YOU WITH HIS NEIGHBOR, for we are members of one another. ²⁶ BE ANGRY, AND YET DO NOT SIN; do not let the sun go down on your anger, ²⁷ and do not give the devil an opportunity. ²⁸ The one who steals must no longer steal; but rather he must labor, producing with his own hands what is good, so that he will have something to share with the one who has need. ²⁹ Let no unwholesome word come out of your mouth, but only such a word as is good for edification according to the need of the moment, so that it will give grace to those who hear. ³⁰ And do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, by whom you were sealed for the day of redemption. ³¹ Let all bitterness, wrath, anger, clamor, and slander be put away from you, along with all malice. ³² Be kind to one another, tender-hearted, forgiving each other, just as God in Christ also has forgiven you.

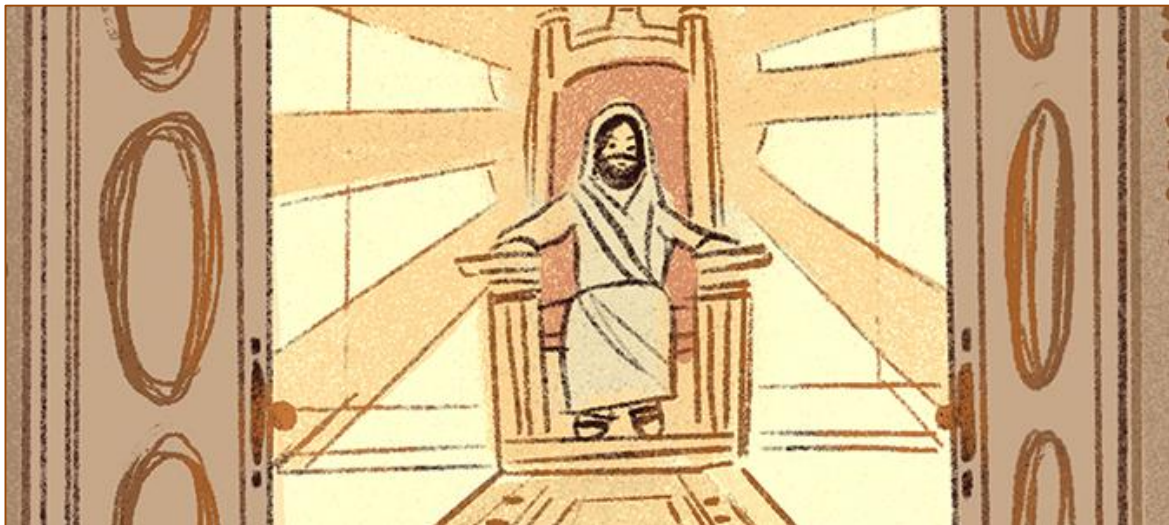
Ascension

Ephesians 1:18-23

¹⁸ I pray that the eyes of your heart may be enlightened, so that you will know what is the hope of His calling, what are the riches of the glory of His inheritance in the saints, ¹⁹ and what is the surpassing greatness of His power toward us who believe. These are in accordance with the working of the strength of His might ²⁰ which He brought about in Christ, when He raised Him from the dead and seated Him at His right hand in the heavenly places, ²¹ far above all rule and authority and power and dominion, and every name that is named, not only in this age, but also in the one to come. ²² And He put all things in subjection under His feet, and gave Him as head over all things to the church, ²³ which is His body, the fullness of Him who fills all in all.

Ephesians 2:1-7

¹ You were dead in your trespasses and sins, ² in which you formerly walked according to the course of this world, according to the prince of the power of the air, of the spirit that is now working in the sons of disobedience. ³ Among them we too all formerly lived in the lusts of our flesh, indulging the desires of the flesh + of the mind, and were by nature children of wrath, even as the rest. ⁴ But God, being rich in mercy, because of His great love with which He loved us, ⁵ even when we were dead in our transgressions, made us alive together **with** Christ (by grace you have been saved), ⁶ and raised us up **with** Him, and seated us **with** Him in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus, ⁷ so that in the ages to come He might show the surpassing riches of His grace in kindness toward us in Christ Jesus.

John 16:7

⁷ [Jesus to His disciples] "I tell you the truth, it is to your advantage that I go away; for if I do not go away, the Helper will not come to you; but if I go, I will send Him to you."

¹⁶ I will ask the Father, and He will give you another Helper, that He may be **with** you forever; ¹⁷ that is the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it does not see Him or know Him, but you know Him because He abides **with** you and will be in you.
