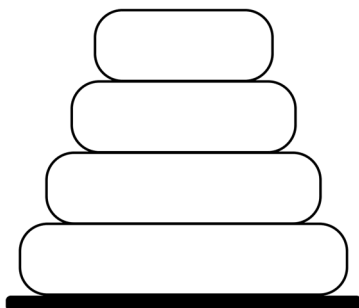
## Selfless: Paul's Letter to the Romans
