

Selfless: Paul's Letter to the Romans

Romans 6-8 – page 942

The Gospel of Jesus Christ reveals God's purpose (Rom. 1-4), demonstrates God's power (Rom. 5-8), fulfills God's plan (Rom. 9-11) and transforms God's people (Rom. 12-16). In chapters 6-8, Paul explains how we are empowered by God to live out of our positional reality in Christ.

Consider yourselves (6:11-14)

Do not present yourselves to sin (6:13)

Present yourselves to God (6:13)

Wretched man that I am! (7:13-25)

I do not do what I want (7:15)

Who will deliver me? (7:24)

Thanks be to God! (7:25)

There is now no condemnation (8:1-39)

Live according to the Spirit (8:5)

We groan inwardly as we wait eagerly (8:23)

Jesus Christ is interceding for us (8:34)
