1 Corinthians 3:5-9 – p. 953

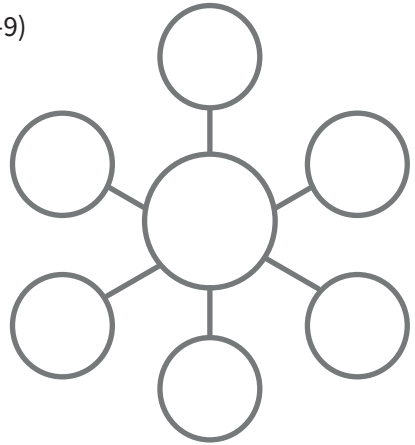
